

**PICKENS COUNTY
MILE CREEK PARK
CAMPSITE RESERVATION POLICIES**

- Person(s) making the reservation must be eighteen years of age or older.
- Maximum length of stay on a particular site during periods of high demand (Memorial Day to Labor Day) is 14 nights. Longer stays are allowed during periods of less demand (After Labor Day).
- We will hold your campsite until you arrive. If you leave and remove your equipment from the site prior to the end of your reservation, we will consider the site vacant.
- Alcoholic beverages and/or other intoxicants or persons under the influence of intoxicants will not be allowed and will be removed from the park. Violation of this policy may result in the loss of reserving campsites at Mile Creek Park in the future.
- All campsite reservations must be paid in full at the time the reservation is made. Campsites are not reserved until park personnel receive payment. Payment should be made in person only at Mile Creek Park at the office from 9 AM to 3 PM Monday-Friday. Reservations made over the phone will be allowed 10 days to mail in payment. If payment is not received in 10 days the reservation will be cancelled.
- Minimum reservation is for seven consecutive nights and maximum is for fourteen consecutive nights. Reservations will always start on a Sunday at 6:00 PM and extend to a Sunday at 4:00 PM. A campsite that has been reserved for less than fourteen consecutive nights can extend the stay up to the limit with out a reservation. Campsite stays cannot be extended if the extension conflicts with the next reservation for that campsite.
- The cost for reserved campsites is the same as for non-reserved campsites.
- The camper is responsible for following all park regulations and policies. Failure to clean the campsite may result in the loss of the right to reserve campsites at Mile Creek Park in the future and/or prosecution for violation of Litter Laws.
- Any violation of the park rules and regulations may result in the forfeiture of the reservation and loss of reservation fee.
- **Reservation fees are non refundable and must be made at least fourteen days in advance.**
- Campsite reservations will be taken beginning on the 3rd Tuesday of January of every year for Pickens County Property Owners. All other reservations will be accepted starting on March 1st. If the 1st falls on a Saturday or Sunday, reservations will be taken on the following Monday.
- Campsites may not be occupied until previous camper has left the site.
- Mile Creek Park reserves the right to post additional rules without notice and to act upon any matter not covered above.
- A \$10.00 service fee will be charged for changing reservation dates.
