Lincoln in the Bardo @ Your Library!

Join the Easley Book Club at the Hampton Memorial Library on Tuesday, November 14th at 7pm to discuss the New York Times bestseller and winner of the Man Booker Prize, *Lincoln in the Bardo* by George Saunders.

In 1862, President Lincoln's beloved 11-year-old son, Willie, died. Newspapers reported that a grief-stricken Lincoln returned to the crypt several times to hold his son's body. From that historical truth, Saunders imagined a tale of love and loss in a supernatural realm. Willie finds himself in the bardo, a transitional state between life and death in the Tibetan tradition. A simultaneously hilarious and terrifying struggle breaks out over Willie's soul.

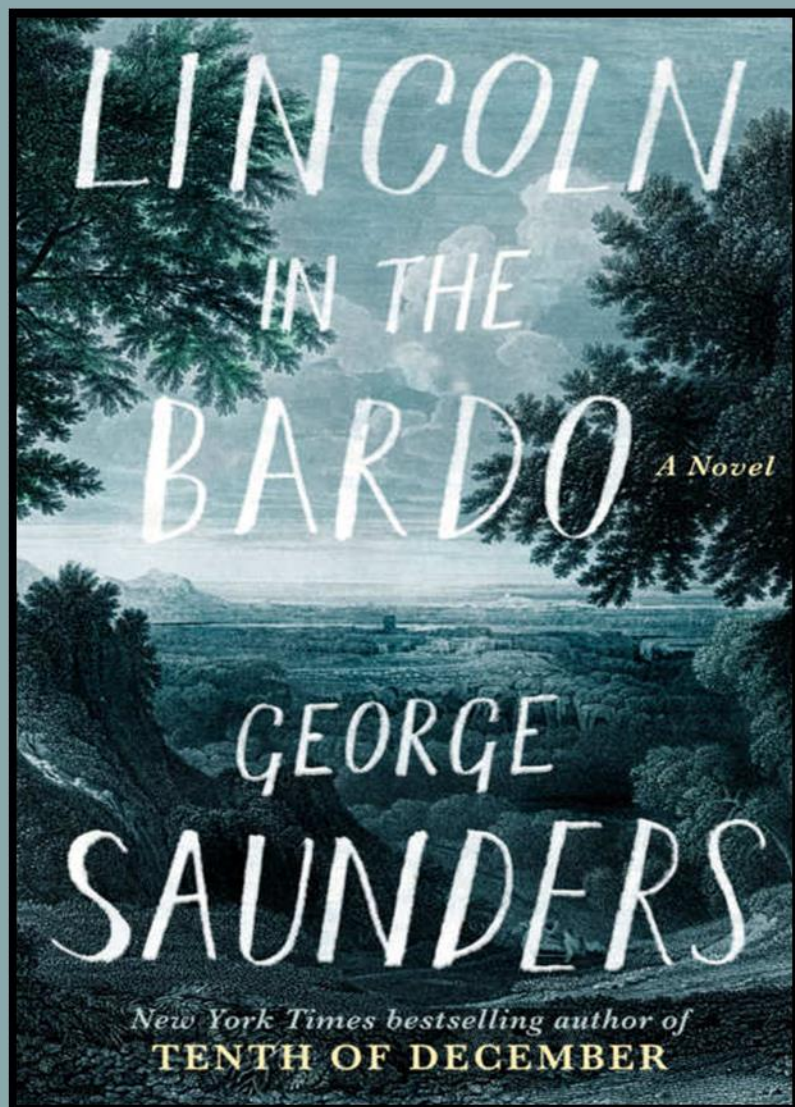
