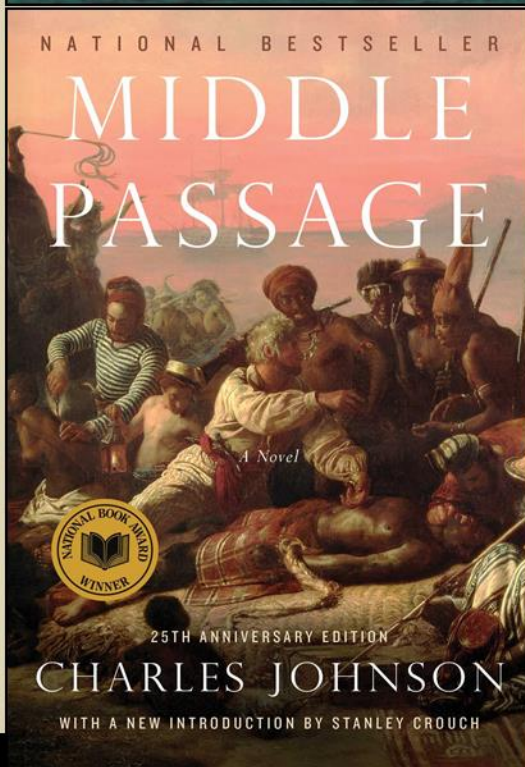
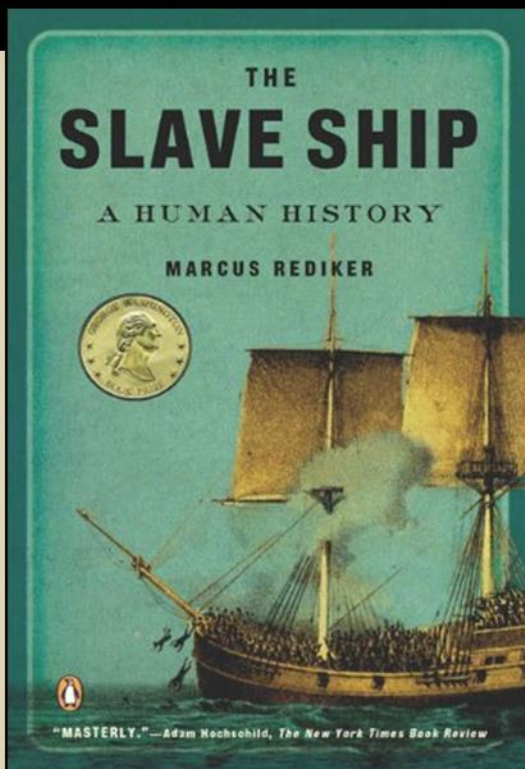
True to Our Native Land: Book Discussion Group @ Your Library!
